- is sick, or has an infectious illness.

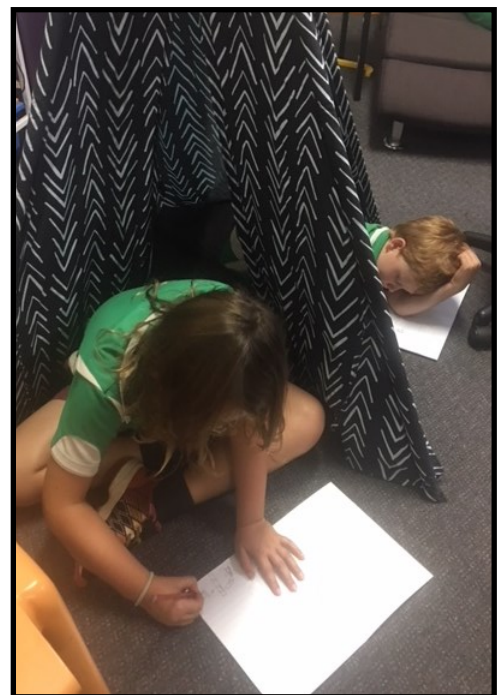
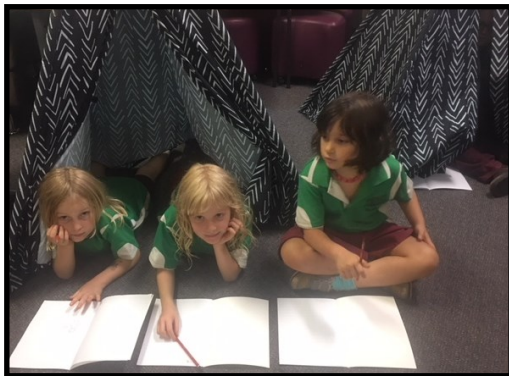
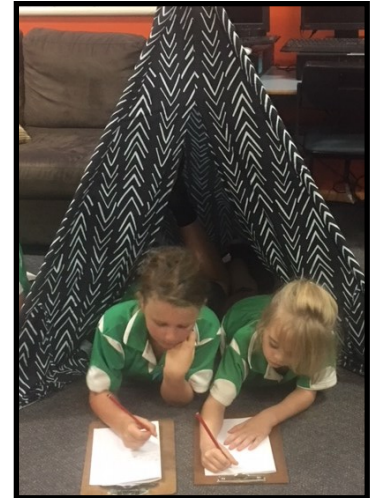
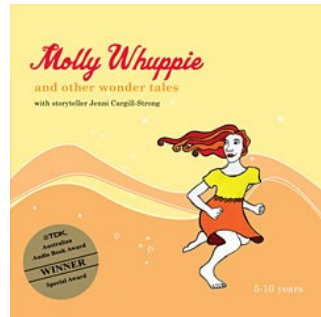
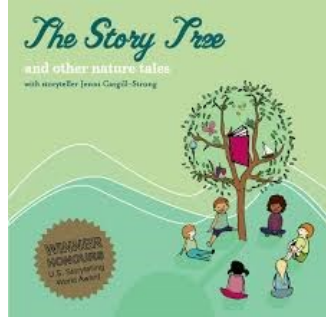
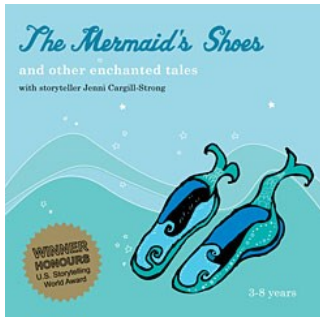
If you are having difficulty getting your child to attend school regularly, you might like to talk to the school principal or the school counsellor.
