

Kindergarten Enrolment 2018

We are taking enrolments for Kindergarten 2019 now! If you have a child starting school next year (or if you know anyone that is looking to enrol next year from our school area) please call the school on 66878267 or speak to Mrs Reid or Mrs McClymont. Our transition to school program will start this term with four half day sessions and will continue in Term 4 with full days. Our transition to school program aims to develop foundations for learning and establish parent partnerships for a smooth and positive transition to kindergarten.

Our transition Program is open to all four and five year old children who are considering Kindergarten in 2018 and may be considering Fernleigh Public School.

Children need to bring a **hat, drink, piece of fruit** and something for **lunch**. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately with **closed in shoes** and **sun safe clothing**.

Getting In and Out of Cars

Please ensure your child always gets in and out of the car through the Safety Door. This is the rear kerb-side door of the car. Never allow your child to get in and out of the car on the traffic side. Please park cars on the school side of the road. Your child should remain in the car until an adult opens the Safety Door.

Help your child buckle up. Make sure their seatbelt is not twisted. It is a good habit to make sure all passengers are securely buckled into a child car seat, booster seat or seatbelt before you start the car.

Never leave a child of any age in a vehicle without adult supervision. Children could play games with car controls that may lead to danger.

Please note U-turns in a school zone are also illegal.
